Job are being deferred because a connection cannot be made to the MAM database.

Issue: Job are being deferred because a connection cannot be made to the MAM database.

Affected Versions: 8.0.x

Symptom: When Moab tries to start a job it can not because MAM can not connect to the database even though the database is up and MAM has access.

Message[0] Failure registering job Start (12345) with accounting manager -- server rejected request with status code 730 - Failed obtaining database connection: DBI connect('dbname=gold;host=localhost','gold',...) failed: FATAL: remaining connection slots are reserved for non-replication superuser connections at /opt/mam/lib/Gold/[Database.pm](#) line 185.

Message[1] cannot modify job - cannot set job '[12345.pbserver.local](#)' attr 'comment:' to 'Failure registering job Start (12345) with accounting manager' (rc: 15018 'Request invalid for state of job MSG=invalid state for job - COMPLETE')

Solution: In this case MAM was making a lot of connections to the database. This is an issue with thread/connection count for MAM.
