

Moab

Moab is unable to write the job to Mongo - "0x2100a76"

Issue: Moab is unable to write the job to Mongo - "0x2100a76"

Symptom:

Affected Version:

Any version below 9.0.1

Solution:

This is a superfluous error message and Moab has stopped printing it out starting in 9.0.1.

In short this error does not come from Moab's attempt to write a job to Mongo. This error is misleading. The error comes from when Moab is examining the transition job to write out to the database, but it notices that the transition job's BSON is empty.

In short you can ignore it until moving to 9.0.1 and higher.
